- AGB membership cards will be required.
- The shoot will be run to GNAS method 1 due to requests made last year (2 ends of three arrows, 2 1/2 minutes per three)
- There will be a raffle and we have made a new set of key rings for you to collect.
- Please try and make any claims for awards etc. before you leave the shoot. If claiming a Rose award make sure it is the one you want as lower awards cannot be claimed later!
